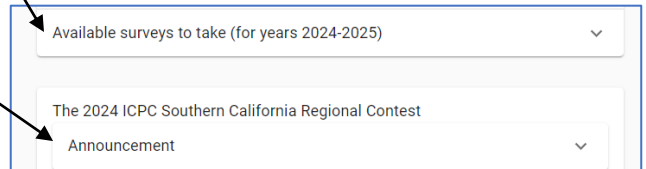
**ANNOUNCEMENT!** There is an "Announcement" feature in ICPC CMS. This and the lunch survey are accessed from your dashboard.

### ONLINE WARM-UP NOVEMBER 2

The Warm-up / Rehearsal Contest will be online, on **November 2**. The purposes of the warm-up are two-fold: one, to stress-test the environment (and uncover any issues so they can be fixed before the contest); and, two, to make sure the contestants are familiar with the environment, so they can concentrate their efforts on the problem set during the contest.

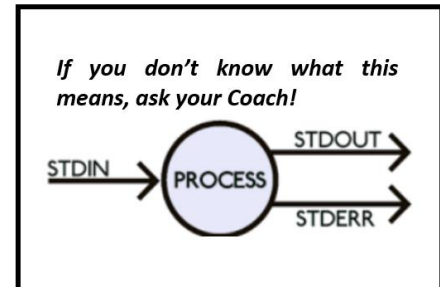
Anyone the coach identifies as a potential team member should participate in the Warm-up. Coaches may assign people to temporary teams for this purpose; it is not necessary to register them in the ICPC system.

**Coaches should request logins for the number of teams that will be participating in the Warm-up, whether they are registered or not. Email the total number needed to [registrar@socalcontest.org](mailto:registrar@socalcontest.org) (one login per team).**

We realize that some teams may not be registered in time for the Warm-up, or have other commitments. SoCal will run the rehearsal as an unattended contest from November 3 through November 13. We strongly recommend that all team members participate. Reserves and potential future contestants are welcome.

Time and additional information will be in the Announcement section of the ICPC CMS.

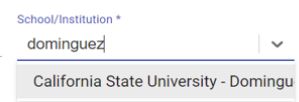

 To use, install VirtualBox 7.1 or later, run VirtualBox Manager, File/Import Appliance. The VM contains a single login, username='icpcuser', password='icpcpw' (without the quotes, of course). *This VM login will differ from the DOMJudge user your teams will connect to during the rehearsal.* Sluggish performance? Increase settings to at least 4 GB RAM and 2 virtual CPUs.
